

Accessories for the home

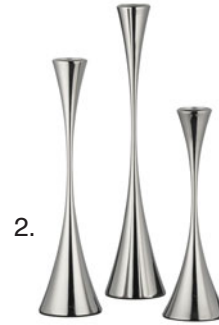
